Our unique **Skills Academy** provides an 8-week training programme with accredited learning outcomes.

This includes boosting your English and maths skills, enhancing health and safety awareness, promoting well-being, fostering teamwork and communication skills, and developing problem-solving and money management abilities.

Additionally, you'll have the chance to meet local employers, career guidance advisors, and industry professionals for valuable insights into your future.

Supporting you throughout your experience.

Our dedicated **Family Business Coordinator** is here to provide ongoing support for both you and your employer to ensure that you succeed.

We recommend weekly check-ins at the start to ensure a smooth start, and we can adjust the frequency as needed.

Information on being an apprentice.



An apprentice will typically work full-time (at least 30 hours per week).



20% of your time must be away from the job (equivalent to one full working day).





You will earn a good wage and be supported to manage money responsibly.



You will be well-trained to become competent in your job, giving you the skills and courage to move on in the future.



You will receive a care leaver apprenticeship bursary of £3,000 to support you with any resources you need for employment e.g. clothes, transport.

How can we support employers?



We offer comprehensive training for employers and their workforce, teaching them how to support young people entering the workforce.



Our Family Business Coordinator will be your point of contact, ensuring a successful experience for both manager and young person.





We will support you and your business through our social media channels to champion the opportunities you provide for young people.



We will celebrate everyone's success at every stage of the journey.



We will prepare young people for work through The Family Business Skills Academy and continue to support you all even once in employment.
